Riham Bahi is an Associate Professor of international relations at the Faculty of Economics and Political Science, Cairo University. Dr. Bahi is also a visiting Professor at the American University in Cairo. Dr. Bahi earned her PhD in International and Public Affairs from Northeastern University in Boston, where she also received her MA in International Relations and Comparative Politics.

Dr. Bahi served as the academic coordinator of the Euro-Mediterranean program at Cairo University (2017-2021). She is also member of the executive committee of the Anti-Harassment Unit at Cairo University. Dr. Bahi is a member of the Future Studies and Risk Management Council, the Academy of Scientific Research and Technology. She serves as Associate Editor for *Review of Economics and Political Science* (the quarterly journal of the Faculty of Economics and Political Science, published by Emerald).

Dr. Bahi has experience in program and curriculum development, capacity building programs for faculty and students, and running short-term study abroad programs in Egypt for American students. She worked as the academic coordinator for Amideast Education Abroad Program (2010-2012).

Dr. Bahi has received many awards and honors, including a Fulbright Pre-Doctoral award and expert credentials from the Center for Effective University Teaching at Northeastern University.

Her research interests include international relations and global governance, Islamic feminism, global and transnational aspects of political Islam, Egypt and U.S. Foreign Policies and Iran-Gulf relations.
